1 INT. ALLISON'S LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

ROONEY - (33, glasses, stylish, red hair, very attractive, but unsure of herself) - is standing in the doorway to the kitchen. The camera pushes in on her.

2 EXT. ALLISON'S HOUSE - NIGHT

JULIAN - (35, scruffy, but well groomed scuff, well dressed and confident) - stands on his tippy toes at the high window looking in. He's got a joint hanging out of his mouth.

JULIAN

Holy fucking christ, Rooney is hot. I want to grab her by the ears and fuck her face. I'm so sure she's fucking dirty.

TERRY - (28, red hair like her sisters, Tattoos, seeming naive, but wise beyond her years and often a couple steps ahead of everyone else, like batman) is revealed to be standing next to Julian as she grabs for the joint from his hand.

TERRY

That is so gross. You realize you're talking about my sister?

JULIAN

Allison used to be hot like that. Allison used to be everything I could have ever imagined in another human being. She was amazing and sexy and loving. Now she's turned into a.. fuddy-duddy.

Terry takes the joint that the've been passing from him.

TERRY

You don't need anymore of that. I don't want you to start crying again.

3 INT. ALLISON'S LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

3

ALLISON - (35, strawberry blonde, The fuddy-duddy in question, a sophisticated seeming homemaker type, less bohemian than her sisters, well spoken and opinionated) races towards the kitchen.

ALLISON

Mom, stop opening the oven. Jesus.

EDITH (O.S.)

Allison, you have to baste if or it'll dry out.

ALLISON

It'll dry out if you keep fucking with it. Stop opening the door.

Two children run in front of Allison.

ALLISON

Stop running in the house.

The doorbell rings. Allison opens the eggplantish door opens to reveal:

MILLIE (33, petite, brunette) and ABE (36, handsome, bald and mustachioed) and their two kids come in the eggplant door.

4 EXT. ALLISON'S HOUSE - NIGHT

4

Julian sees from the window and puts out the joint.

JULIAN

Oh, shit. My sister and her kids are here. Should probably get back in there.

5 INT. ALLISON'S LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

5

Allison hugs the kids and then Millie and Abe.

ALLISON

So great to see you guys!

Rooney moves forward for her turn to greet them. As she passes she hits **OWEN** - (35, semi long curly hair, boyish, but mean) on the shoulder.

OWEN

What?

ROONEY

Be friendlier.

OWEN

What does that mean?

ALAN and EDITH, a couple in their 60's stand arm in arm. Alan has a birthday crown on his head. Others have birthday hats. There are balloons and a sign: "Happy Birthday, Pops".

Owen walks up to **LAURA** - 30, short, stylish hair, lots of tattoos and holds out his land.

OWEN

I don't think we've met yet, I'm Owen.

LAURA

Laura.

Julian comes in, Terry behind him.

JULIAN

Oh, look who it is! You guys are getting so big! What's an uncle gotta do to get a hug around here?

6 INT. ALLISON'S KITCHEN - DAY

6

Allison lights the candles on the cake. It's a close-up of her face with the candles in the foreground. This is in slow motion and the credits sequence. She then picks up the cake and we transition from the opening credits song to singing "Happy Birthday" as she walks into the dining room. Alan blows out the candles. Everyone cheers. Allison starts to cut the cake and Rooney distributes. Terry stares at Julian. He catches her, She's embarrassed, but he makes a funny face to defuse it.

ALAN

Dark chocolate?

ROONEY

Dark chocolate.

ALLISON

We know you, pop.

ROONEY

Hahah. That's why there are so many strawberries on it.

ALAN

There had better not be, I hate fruit on my dessert.

ALLISON

There are no strawberries.

ALAN

Rooney, you little shit hook.

ROONEY

Just razzing ya, old man.

ALAN

You kids are too much. Seriously, Thank you for everything. You all made this old man so happy. I'm so proud of all four of my daughters and the beautiful people they've turned out to be.

EDITH

There are only three, Alan.

ALAN

You gotta be shittin' me. Did we lose one?

EDITH

No, dear, always three.

ALAN

Well, I'll be damned.

EDITH

And thank you Millie and Abe for bringing the little ones, because none of our kids seem to be interested in children.

JULIAN

Easy now.

ALAN

The kids are so fun. But I've been trying to figure it out, what are the kids to me?

TERRY

What do you mean, Dad?

ALAN

Are they my second cousins?

ALLISON

No, Dad. Not even close.

MILLIE

Oh, I don't know.

ROONEY

It's like an in law thing, right?

JULIAN

Yeah, they're your daughter's husband's sister's kids.

ALAN

That's too complicated. I'll just call them wonderful. Thank you guys for being here and being a part of our family as well.

MILLIE

Aw, we love you guys.

ALAN

Hey, Millie, you still playing in that band? Et.. Etch-A-Sketch? What is it?

MILLIE

Eta Carinae. Yeah, as much as we can we try to play. It's hard with the kids and all, but we make it work. We're actually playing next Tuesday at the Casbah.

ALLISON

Oh, we should go.

ROONEY

Yeah, I want to go.

Owen rolls his eyes. Rooney and Owen get in a scoffing match.

ALAN

You know, I played the Casbah many a time in my day.

TERRY

We know, Pop.

ALAN

My band, Biscuit Joiner, was a bit of a thing around these parts.

ROONEY

We know, Pop.

ALAN

I know you girls know, I was telling Millie.

MILLIE

I know, pop.

7 INT. ALLISON'S PIANO ROOM - NIGHT

Terry plays piano. The family gathered around singing along.

8 INT. ALLISON'S KITCHEN - DAY

8

7

Allison and Terry are at opposite sides of the long, skinny kitchen. Allison is wiping down counters, Terry does the dishes. Rooney comes in.

TERRY

She's having a tough time, so I invited her. I hope that's okay.

ALLISON

I don't mind it at all, and you know Dad loves everyone.

ROONEY

Hi, I came to help. You talking about that girl you brought?

Rooney starts to put away dishes.

TERRY

Yeah, Laura.

ROONEY

That's sweet that you brought her. Let's make her feel really welcome. Where is she?

ALLISON

I saw her chatting with the boys. They probably roped her into smoking pot out front.

Rooney's face drops, but she tries to hide it.

ROONEY

The boys meaning Julian and Owen?

ALLISON

Yeah, it's just about time for one of their little pow wows.

TERRY

You can't say "pow wow". Not PC.

ALLISON

What are you going to do about it?

TERRY

Cancel your ass.

9

ROONEY

I'm going to go check on her.

She exits.

TERRY

You think she's okay?

ALLISON

What do you mean? Like with Owen?

TERRY

Yeah, he's a prick and a half.

ALLISON

He's got anger stuff for sure.

TERRY

I thought she was going to break up with him.

ALLISON

She told you that?

TERRY

Yeah, she's threatened, like, hundreds of times actually.

ALLISON

Really?

TERRY

She goes as far as to pack her stuff up, but always just unpacks it the next day.

ALLISON

Wow, I had no idea. I guess Rooney and I don't talk as much as we used to.

9 EXT. ALLISON'S HOUSE - DAY

Owen, Laura and Julian are in a circle, passing a joint.

JULIAN

What kind of stuff do you do?

LAURA

I do mostly mixed media watercolor ink and acrylic portraits, pulling symbolism from dreams and archetypal psychology.

OWEN

Sounds too deep for me.

LAURA

I don't know, not that deep.

JULIAN

A lot of things just go over his head, he's not an intellectual like you and me.

OWEN

Fuck you, Julian.

JULIAN

Fuck you, Owen.

LAURA

You guys are funny.

JULIAN

You ever show anywhere?

LAURA

Yeah, I actually have a show next week. The opening is Friday.

OWEN

Oh, I'd like to come.

LAURA

I'd love that.

OWEN

Then I'll be there.

LAURA

I'd love it if all of you came.

JULIAN

I'll talk to Allison, I'm sure she'd be into it.

OWEN

Gotta talk to the boss.

JULIAN

Well, you know.

OWEN

So whipped.

JULIAN

Go read a comic book, Owen.

OWEN

There's nothing wrong with comics.

LAURA

what kind of stuff do you do, Owen?

OWEN

I'm a cartoonist. I'm a printmaker. I mean, to pay the bills I mostly screen print t-shirts, but I draw too.

LAURA

Cool. You have your own shop?

OWEN

I do.

LAURA

I'd like to come see it sometime.

OWEN

Yeah, I'd love to do some prints for you sometime.

LAURA

That would be wonderful.

Rooney comes out to find them smoking.

ROONEY

Oh, so this is where the bad kids hang out.

LAURA

If ya'll will excuse me, I need to use the pee pee palace.

Laura exits.

ROONEY

What was that?

OWEN

Terry's friend Laura. You met her.

ROONEY

What were you talking about? She sure skedaddled when I got here.

OWEN

She's a painter. We were talking about that.

ROONEY

Ooo, you love painters, don't you?

OWEN

Jesus Christ, Rooney, we were just chatting, making conversation. We're at a party, that's what you're supposed to do. That's what you told me to do. And Julian was right here.

JULIAN

It's true, I was.

ROONEY

You get so defensive, it makes you look guilty.

OWEN

Ahhhh! You are unreasonable.

Owen storms back into the house. Rooney sits down on the wicker patio chair and puts her head in her hands.

Julian sits next to her and passes her the joint. She giggles and takes a hit.

JULIAN

Everything okay?

ROONEY

He wants me to follow him and talk him down. I'm not going to.

JULIAN

Forgive me, it's none of my business, but are you two okay?

ROONEY

ugh. He's just in a mood.

JULIAN

That happen a lot?

ROONEY

Moods?

JULIAN

Yeah.

ROONEY

Oh, yeah. On both our parts. We fight a lot these days.

JULIAN

I'm sorry to hear that.

ROONEY

Do you fight with Allison?

Rooney gets up and walks to the zebra ashtray to get rid of the growing ash and the end of the joint. Julian stands as well.

JULIAN

Of course, everyone fights. We go through periods where we fight more often, but we're married. That's what married people do.

ROONEY

Yeah.

JULIAN

Plus, you probably hear all about my fights with Allison already.

ROONEY

No, not really. Allison and I aren't as close as we once were.

JULIAN

Come on, you're alway together.

ROONEY

I mean, yeah, I've always been close with my sisters, but Allison and I have drifted. She certainly doesn't talk to me about you. I used to feel so close to her.

JULIAN

Yeah, I know that drifting feeling well.

ROONEY

What do you mean? You don't feel close to Allison?

JULIAN

Well, you know how she is, you just described it. She can be so cold. I'm supposed to be the closest person to her and sometimes she feels so distant.

ROONEY

That's so sad.

Rooney looks like she might cry.

10

JULIAN

It's okay. Allison and I are fine, I was just venting. I didn't mean to make you sad.

ROONEY

No, It's everything. You're telling me that the most perfect marriage I've ever seen is a sham. My boyfriend sucks. There's no hope for anything.

JULIAN

Come here.

He hugs her.

ROONEY

You smell good.

She breaks the hug.

JULIAN

You okay?

ROONEY

Yeah.

She looks at him longingly. He likes it, so he lingers.

ROONEY

Should we go back inside?

JULIAN

Yeah, let's see what's going on.

10 INT. ALLISON'S BEDROOM - DAY

Terry and Allison are sitting on the bed drinking wine.

LAURA

Hi, can I hang with you guys?

ALLISON

Of course you can.

TERRY

Are you having a good time?

LAURA

Yeah, everyone is so nice. I feel very welcomed. Your dad is sweet. (MORE)

LAURA (CONT'D)

I think your parents are the cutest little married couple I've ever seen.

TERRY

They're actually not married.

LAURA

They never married?

ALLISON

They did, they're divorced. We were teenager when it happened, but it didn't stick. They got back together after 7 years. True love always wins.

TERRY

Our parents are boyfriend and girlfriend.

LAURA

Wow. That's such a sweet story. I'm going to cry.

TERRY

I know, man, isn't it wild?

ALLISON

So why are you here, Laura? I don't mean that in a rude way, you're more than welcome, but why would you want to be at our dad's birthday party?

LAURA

Well, I just didn't really want to be alone. I very recently went through a break up. I asked Terry if she wanted to hang out.

TERRY

I said I have Dad's party, but she's more than welcome to join and she came.

ALLISON

Well, we're happy to have you.

LAURA

Thank you.

ALLISON

I don't know a damn thing about you, Laura? Tell me everything.

LAURA

Well, I'm an artist, I paint and I absolutely love plants. And that's about everything.

ALLISON

Plants? Oh man, I could use you! I need to add a little life to this place with some plants, but I never know what to get. What's okay for the cats? And my thumb is so the opposite of green.

TERRY

Red.

LAURA

I'd love to take you to the nursery and help you out.

ALLISON

Oh yeah? Really?

LAURA

Of course! It'd be fun!

ALLISON

How about next Tuesday?

LAURA

Perfect.

ALLISON

It's a date!

TERRY

Yay! I love that you two are going to be friends.

11 INT. ALLISON'S PIANO ROOM - DAY

11

Mille plays a song with one of her kids, family singing along. Terry again watches Julian as he sings and picks up a kid.

12 INT. OWEN'S CAR - NIGHT

12

On the ride home Owen and Rooney sit in silence until...

OWEN

Why are you giving me the silent treatment?

ROONEY

I'm not.

OWEN

You are. What's wrong?

ROONEY

I'm just disappointed in the way you were talking to that girl.

OWEN

Oh, my god. We were just chatting. I was just being polite. What am I going to hit on some girl at your Dad's birthday party?

ROONEY

Yes, that's what I'm worried about

OWEN

What about you?

ROONEY

What about me what?

OWEN

Julian.

ROONEY

What about him?

OWEN

He clearly has a crush on you.

ROONEY

Please. That's not true.

OWEN

He flirts with you and you like it and you feel guilty and that's why you attack me for this shit.

ROONEY

Attack you?

OWEN

That's what you're doing.

ROONEY

You are such a fucking idiot.

OWEN

See? What the fuck does that help? I'm trying to have a grown up fucking conversation about this.

ROONEY

No, you're not, you're accusing me of flirting with my sisters husband, which is laughable.

OWEN

You make me feel so fucking small I don't know what to do.

Rooney looks out the window.

13 INT. OWEN'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

13

Owen's small studio apartment has art covered walls and there are comic book boxes stacked up taking too much room. Rooney is getting dressed for bed, Owen is in bed reading a comic book, but looking up at Rooney, waiting for her to say something. She gets in bed and turns off the light without saying a word.

14 INT. TERRY'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

14

Terry climbs the stairs and opens the door. her dog, BOOMER, is super excited to see her. There's a polaroid of Terry and Julian framed on the end table.

TERRY

Hey, Boomer! You gotta go potty? You want to go for a walk?

15 INT. ALLISON'S BATHROOM - NIGHT

15

Allison brushes her teeth in the mirror. Julian comes up behind her and kisses her on the cheek and gets his toothbrush ready.

JULIAN

Another successful Birthday party.

ALLISON

You think so? (mouth full)

JULIAN

I don't know what you said.

Allison spits into the sink.

ALLISON

You think so?

JULIAN

I do.

ALLISON

He seemed happy.

Julian is now brushing.

JULIAN

He was so happy. (mouth full)

ALLISON

I don't know what you said.

Julian flips her off.

16 INT. MOM AND DAD'S HOUSE - NIGHT

16

Alan and Edith slow dance in their kitchen.

17 EXT. NORTH PARK NURSERY - DAY

17

Allison pours mini bottles of wine into her water bottle and shares it with Laura. They walk and look at plants.

LAURA

Ooo, I like this for you.

ALLISON

That's, like, exactly what I was thinking.

LAURA

Perfect.

ALLISON

So how are you holding up?

LAURA

What do you mean?

ALLISON

From the break-up. You doing okay?

LAURA

Oh, Yeah, mostly I feel relief. I'm still sad, but it needed to end. It was ugly.

ALLISON

Ugly how?

LAURA

She was very manipulative, she was very guilt trippy.

ALLISON

She? It was a girl? You had a relationship with a girl? I had no idea you were gay.

LAURA

I don't have a specific thing I'm attracted to. I like to try all shapes and sizes and genders.

ALLISON

Like bisexual?

LAURA

Something like that. Terry never told you how we met?

ALLISON

Haven't heard this story. Should I be scared?

LAURA

Nooo, I saw her at Bar Pink and tried to make a move and she didn't go for it, but we had hit it off so well that we became good friends. She thinks it's funny now. Likes to tell people. That's why I assumed you knew.

ALLISON

I see.

LAURA

Are you weirded out?

ALLISON

No, it's the 20s, I'm open minded as hell. I just didn't know.

LAURA

How open minded?

ALLISON

What do you mean?

Laura kisses Allison.

LAURA

I've wanted to do that since I met you.

Allison scoffs and storms off.

18 INT. OWEN'S STUDIO - DAY

18

Owen is printing shirts, he has ink all over him. He is interrupted by a knock. Rooney and she's wearing a fur coat.

OWEN

What's up? I'm super busy, I have to have this run done by 2pm.

Rooney comes in and takes off her coat. Underneath she's wearing green lingerie.

ROONEY

It's just the darnedest thing, I have this natural immunity against poisons, toxins, the pain and suffering of others. Go figure.

OWEN

What is this?

ROONEY

Poison Ivy.

OWEN

Yeah, I know. Why right now? I'm fucked busy.

ROONEY

I just wanted to apologize for last night.

OWEN

Rooney, this is nice and I accept your apology, but I don't have time for this. I really have to get back to work.

Rooney is defeated. She puts her coat back on and storms out.

19 EXT. ALLISON'S HOUSE - DAY

19

Julian comes out of the eggplant door and sees Rooney standing in the front yard. She's been crying.

JULIAN

Rooney, you okay? What happened?

20

ROONEY

I'm sorry. This is embarrassing. I came to talk to Allison, but I was scared, I didn't come to the door.

JULIAN

Why were you scared?

Rooney starts to cry.

ROONEY

I don't know. It's like I said, we're not so close anymore.

JULIAN

Allison isn't here. She's with Laura. Is there something I can do for you? Are you okay?

ROONEY

I'm okay. Owen is just an asshole.

JULIAN

Well, Yeah. Do you want to talk about it?

ROONEY

No, it's not worth talking about.

JULIAN

Okay. Well, can I buy you a cup of coffee? Maybe we can talk about something else.

ROONEY

I'd like that a lot.

20 EXT. DARK HORSE NORTH PARK - DAY

Julian and Rooney get their coffees and leave the window.

ROONEY

Thanks for the coffee. I really appreciate it, you didn't have to.

JULIAN

Oh, it's nothing, my pleasure. You feeling any better?

ROONEY

Yeah, thanks. I think just someone being sweet to me is all I needed, Owen is such a dick.

JULIAN

I'm sorry, you don't deserve that.

ROONEY

It's just stupid. I wish I could leave him.

JULIAN

Forgive me if I'm getting too personal, but why don't you?

ROONEY

I ask myself that all the time.

JULIAN

What have you come up with?

ROONEY

I dunno. I'm scared to not be with him. Who will take care of him?

JULIAN

Rooney, that's not your problem.

ROONEY

I guess. I still love him, I just don't think I want to be with him anymore. I don't know, it's complicated.

JULIAN

No, I get it.

ROONEY

I'm sorry, Julian. This is getting heavy.

JULIAN

I'm so sorry, you said you wanted to talk about something else.

ROONEY

No, thanks for being concerned. Nobody generally is. You've been really sweet.

JULIAN

I'm just happy to have some company. Hey, you want to see where I work?

ROONEY

What?

JULIAN

Well, that's where I was headed when I ran into you, and I still have a couple things to do there real quick.

21 INT. JULIAN'S STUDIO - DAY

21

Julian sits at the mixing board and plays a song for Rooney.

ROONEY

I like it. It's vibey. Is that the word?

JULIAN

Yeah, you feel that?

ROONEY

Yeah.

JULIAN

Yeah?

ROONEY

Yeah.

He turns it off.

JULIAN

I fucking hate it. It's what pays the bills though.

22 INT. JULIAN'S STUDIO - DAY

22

Rooney and Julian play ping pong.

ROONEY

Game point.

JULIAN

Fuck. I had no idea you'd be so good.

ROONEY

Buhahahah. That's how I take all your money.

JULIAN

Fucking shark.

23

23 EXT. JULIAN'S STUDIO BALCONY - DAY

Julian and Rooney pass a joint.

JULIAN

I gotta tell ya, you embarrassed me on that ping pong table.

ROONEY

Aw, Jul, you weren't so bad. I just don't think you should join any leagues or anything anytime soon. Keep practicing though.

JULIAN

I play every god damn day.

Rooney smiles real big.

ROONEY

Thanks for letting me hang and having fun with me. I was having a rough morning and you made me forget all about it.

JULIAN

You feeling better now?

ROONEY

Yeah. A lot. Thanks. You're sweet.

She lovingly scratches his back.

ROONEY

Rematch?

24 INT. OWEN'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

24

Rooney reads a book in bed. Owen is next to her with a comic.

OWEN

What are you reading?

ROONEY

Since when do you give a fuck?

OWEN

Come on, Rooney. It doesn't have to be like this. Why are you so pissed off?

ROONEY

Umm... because you rejected me.

OWEN

I did not reject you.

ROONEY

I showed up at your fucking studio in almost nothing but a fur coat, reciting lines from some stupid cartoon, trying to fuck you as some kind of apology and to put this argument behind us, and you turned me down. You know how hard it is to do something like that? How hard it is to be that vulnerable?

OWEN

Oh, whatever. The whole thing was you gaslighting my about Laura because you and Julian have your little thing.

ROONEY

Julian and I do not have a "little thing".

OWEN

He definitely likes you.

Owen gets up, walks to the kitchen and opens a beer. It's small studio apartment, so the conversation is not interrupted.

ROONEY

As a friend. You just don't understand the concept of a friend of the opposite sex because you want to fuck anything and everything.

OWEN

Guy's a scumbag. I can smell it.

ROONEY

He's not. He's sweet. He bought me coffee today and listened to me bitch about you and didn't want anything in return. He was just being a good friend, not trying to fuck me like you would have been.

OWEN

You were with him today?

ROONEY

Yeah, I went to see Allison, but she wasn't there and I was crying so he asked me what was wrong.

OWEN

And then you went on a fucking date with him.

Owen walks back over to her side of the room.

ROONEY

Are you fucking listening to anything I'm saying? It wasn't a date.

OWEN

And you're telling him shit about me. Our private stuff. How is that supposed to make me feel?

ROONEY

Owen, if you'd talk to me I wouldn't have to find other people to listen.

OWEN

We talk. What the fuck are we doing right now!?!

ROONEY

You're yelling at me. You don't listen to me.

OWEN

Jesus Christ, I can't do anything right, can I?

ROONEY

I didn't say that.

OWEN

Whatever. I'm over this.

He storms out.

ROONEY

Where are you going?

OWEN

Out.

Owen walks around the galley. There are paintings on the wall, psychedelic video being projected, performance art, Etc. Laura finds him as he's watching a crazy art film on a small old TV.

LAURA

Hey, you made it.

OWEN

Almost wish I hadn't. Look at this clown.

In the video MARCO, who is also walking around the gallery, repeats the same line over and over again and it goes back in forth between a tight shot and a wide shot.

LAURA

That's my friend Marco. I actually particularly like this.

OWEN

Oh, sorry.

LAURA

It's ok. You don't have to like it.

OWEN

So where are yours?

LAURA

Over here.

They walk over to her paintings.

OWEN

See, I like these. Yours are great. I love the colors.

LAURA

Why thank you.

OWEN

I think I want to get this tattooed on my butt.

Laura cackles.

OWEN

Really. Very good shit.

LAURA

You want to grab a drink?

OWEN

Absolutely.

They get beers out of a cooler and Owen puts cash in the donation jar. They cheers and drink.

LAURA

Thanks for coming.

OWEN

Thanks for having me.

MAISY (O.S.)

Laura!!!!

MAISY, stylish, almost 70s looking, comes out from behind Laura and hugs her.

LAURA

Oh my god, hey!

MAISY

Heyo!

LAURA

I'm so glad to see you!

MAISY

I love you!

LAURA

Maisy, this is my friend Owen.

MAISY

Hello, Owen.

OWEN

Hello, Maisy.

LAURA

Owen is a cartoonist.

MAISY

V cool. Do you have anything up?

OWEN

No, just here to support Laura.

MAISY

Oh, that's cute.

OWEN

What does that mean "That's cute"?

MAISY

Just means that it's cute.

OWEN

Okay.

LAURA

Maisy IS in the show.

OWEN

Oh yeah, What's yours?

LAURA

The monster cat things over there.

OWEN

Oh yeah I saw those. They're cute.

MAISY

TERRY

Yeah, I've been telling you that for ages.

ROONEY

You don't know the half of it.

TERRY

What do you mean?

ROONEY

He held a knife to my throat when I said I was leaving him.

TERRY

Holy shit! Are you serious?!!

ROONEY

I wasn't even scared of him doing it. I was thinking, you don't want to do this. You don't want to go to jail.

TERRY

That's so fucked up. You should have called the cops. You should still call the cops.

ROONEY

No, it won't accomplish anything. It's over now. He won't try anything again. He's probably embarrassed now more than anything.

TERRY

Rooney, I'm so sorry.

ROONEY

Don't worry about me. I'm hopeful. Good things are coming. Hook me up with one of those dumplings, you fucking dumpling hog.

63 INT. OWEN'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

Owen pours shots for he and Laura. He's already very drunk.

LAURA

Are you okay?

OWEN

No.

LAURA

Can I help you? Is there something I can do? Do you want to talk?

OWEN

Of course I want to talk, why else would I invite you here? What's your favorite movie? Favorite color?

LAURA

You know what I mean.

OWEN

Do I want to talk about Rooney? Not with you.

LAURA

Okay, well, I'm more than happy to do that. Seems like it might help.

OWEN

Fuck you. You don't know what will help me. You're just like her, think you know everything.

LAURA

Again, just trying to help.

OWEN

I know. I'm sorry I'm such an asshole to you.

LAURA

I get it. You're hurting.

OWEN

See, that's what makes you better than her, you are willing to make an attempt to see my side of things. She isn't willing to do that even the slightest iota.

LAURA

Can you stop comparing me to her?

OWEN

Fair. But you are better.

LAURA

Okay.

OWEN

Nicer, more thoughtful, way better looking.

LAURA

Thank you for the complements, but you're still comparing me to her.

OWEN

You're right, I'm sorry.

He leans in and kisses her. She kisses him back. He takes off her shirt, wasting no time.

64 INT. OWEN'S APARTMENT - MORNING

64

Laura wakes up and tries to cuddle up next Owen and gets pushed away. She tries again and he pushes her more aggressively.

OWEN

Stop, I need to sleep.

LAURA

I want to go back to sleep too. I was just trying to cuddle.

OWEN

I'm not really in the mood to cuddle. I had the shittist day on record yesterday and I'm hung over as fuck and I just want to sleep.

LAURA

Jesus, you're such an asshole. I thought last night that it was just the liquor talking.

OWEN

I need you to get the fuck out. I don't want you in my house being a bitch to me while I'm trying to sleep. Get out.

LAURA

Fine. Fucking cock sucker.

OWEN

Cunt. Bye.

She storms out.

65 INT. OWEN'S APARTMENT HALLWAY - DAY

65

Laura gets dressed in the hallway and calls the elevator.

66 EXT. JULIAN'S STUDIO BALCONY - DAY

66

Julian looks at the city and smokes a joint.

67 INT. JULIAN'S STUDIO - DAY

67

Julian is working on mixing that song he hates when he gets a knock at the door. It's Rooney wearing a fur coat.

JULIAN

Hi! What are you doing here?

ROONEY

Oh no, should I not have come.

JULIAN

No, No, it's a very pleasant surprise. Come on in.

She comes in.

JULIAN

It's really good to see you.

She drops the fur coat. she's not wearing anything underneath.

JULIAN

Oh. Wow.

She kisses him. He lifts her up onto the ping pong table.

SPRING.

68 INT. LEFTY'S PIZZERIA - DAY

68

Laura and Allison have pizza.

ALLISON

What did you want to talk to me about?

LAURA

Well, I've been thinking and I care about you a lot.

ALLISON

I care about you too, Laura.

LAURA

You do?

ALLISON

Of course. You're wonderful.

LAURA

That will make this next part easier.

ALLISON

Spit it out already.

LAURA

I think we should be in a relationship.

ALLISON

A relationship?

LAURA

Yeah. I want you to be my significant other. I want to be with you.

ALLISON

Laura, I'm married.

LAURA

I know, I'm not necessarily saying to leave Julian. He could be there too. It could be a poly situation, or even a triad.

ALLISON

Triad?

LAURA

Like a trouple thing. I don't know. The point is we should be significantly in each others lives. Don't you think?

ALLISON

No, I don't think so, Laura. I think that's absolutely crazy.

LAURA

Crazy?

ALLISON

Yes, crazy. I have a husband, who I love. Who you know doesn't even want to have sex with you again, much less be in a weird three person relationship.

LAURA

Well, how do you think of me?

ALLISON

As my friend.

LAURA

Oh, come on. We're so much more than friends.

ALLISON

Laura, I have a lot of fun with you and I do feel very connected to you, but that's all I want it to be.

LAURA

I get it.

ALLISON

Maybe we shouldn't even see each other for a while.

LAURA

What?

ALLISON

This is just kind of weird. I just think I need some time to think.

LAURA

Okay. That makes me sad though.

ALLISON

It's not forever. I'll call you. Everything will be fine.

Allison walks out. Laura is left alone with her pizza.

105 INT. MOTEL ROOM - NIGHT

105

Julian is in the shower.

JULIAN

Can you grab me a towel?

Rooney brings him a towel and then stares out him as he dries himself off. She's got a big smile, she's completely smitten.

JULIAN

What?

ROONEY

Nothing. I just... I think I love you.

He gets a big smile himself.

69 EXT. THORN ST. AND 28TH - DAY

69

Allison and Julian ride bikes.

JULIAN

That hill was rough. This is fucked up. Why do people do this?

ALLISON

This was your idea. What made you want to go for a bike ride all of the sudden?

JULIAN

Rooney talked me into it. Been trying to get me to start riding.

ALLISON

You've been spending time with Rooney?

JULIAN

I don't know, we chat a little. I'd say of your sisters, I'm probably closer to Terry.

ALLISON

I suppose that's true. You two are thick as thieves.

JULIAN

She's my buddy.

ALLISON

Julian, are you okay?

JULIAN

No, I think I might pass out.

ALLISON

No, I mean... The last few weeks things have felt a little... off.

JULIAN

Off how?

ALLISON

I don't know how to describe it. Just off.

JULIAN

You mean since Laura?

ALLISON

Laura?

JULIAN

Come on, Al, the threesome. You think I've been acting different since then?

ALLISON

Yeah, I guess so.

JULIAN

Are you upset that I didn't want to do it again?

ALLISON

No, it's not that. You've just been distant.

JULIAN

I don't know. Work has been busy, but I love you. This bike date was my idea. A bad idea, but still I wanted to spend time with you.

ALLISON

That's true.

JULIAN

And, if I'm completely honest, I've felt like you've been a little distant yourself. Off in your head.

ALLISON

I haven't been. I've just been giving you space.

JULIAN

Okay, well, I don't need space. Do you?

ALLISON

No. I need my husband.

JULIAN

And I need my wife.

ALLISON

Hearing you say that is nice.

JULIAN

Then let's have a nice day together today, what do you say?

ALLISON

Okay.

JULIAN

Let's stop and have lunch.

They stop at a picnic spot. Julian starts to lock his bike. Allison checks her phone. There are a lot of missed calls and texts from Laura. Allison looks concerned, but ignores it.

70 INT. BIRD PARK - DAY

70

Julian and Allison have a picnic. They're engaged in conversation. Julian is being goofy.

71 INT. ALLISON'S LIVING ROOM - DAY

71

Allison and Julian play cards and laugh, having a gay old time.

72 INT. SUSHI PLACE - DAY

72

Allison and Julian go crazy ordering everything on the menu.

73 EXT. MONTCLAIR PARK - DAY

73

Millie and Allison sit in the shade while Julian plays with the kids. Allison very lovingly watches Julian.

74 INT. ALLISON'S LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

74

Allison and Julian are in their pajamas on the couch. She takes the remote from him and jumps on top of him.

75 EXT. LA LOUPE - DAY

75

Boomer is tied up in front of the store.

76 INT. LA LOUPE - DAY

76

Allison and Terry are walking around the store.

TERRY

Holy shit! Allison, really?

ALLISON

Yeah, and at first it was great. Eye opening, refreshing, beautiful. But it's gotten weird. She's gotten weird.

TERRY

Weird how?

ALLISON

She asked me to be in a relationship with her?

TERRY

Really? What about Julian? You have a husband. She knows that.

ALLISON

She wanted to include him. Like, a throuple.

TERRY

Oh my god. What did you say?

ALLISON

I shot her down, but when I did I got a little scared and told her I needed space. I told her not to call me, and she's been calling and texting non-stop.

TERRY

She gets clingy.

ALLISON

Now you tell me. Why didn't you warn me?

TERRY

I didn't know you'd start a fucking relationship with her. How could I know that? That's insane.

ALLISON

I know. It's fucked up.

TERRY

Well, what has she been saying?

ALLISON

Trying to get my attention. Just pleading to talk to me.

TERRY

And have you?

ALLISON

No, I've been ignoring her.

TERRY

Maybe that's not the best move.

ALLISON

What am I supposed to do?

TERRY

You need to have a conversation with her.

ALLISON

And say what?

TERRY

I don't know. How do you feel?

ALLISON

Like it was just supposed to be fun. That's she's made it heavy. She's made it something it's not. And the guilt is overwhelming. I feel so bad for Jule. For a while I couldn't even look at him. He noticed and has been trying so hard. I love him. I want to be with him and no one else.

TERRY

Well, that's what you say.

ALLISON

You're right. It's just hard.

TERRY

Some shit is hard. Be an adult and clean up your mess.

ALLISON

Damn, harsh. But 100% right.

TERRY

I fucking know.

77 INT. ALLISON'S LIVING ROOM - DAY

Allison paces. After building up the courage, she sits down, pulls out her phone and calls Laura.

LAURA

Hi.

ALLISON

Hi.

LAURA

I was so excited when I saw that it was you calling. How are you?

ALLISON

Laura, the calls and texts have to stop. I'm happily married and just want to be with Julian. Please respect that.

LAURA

Of course. I completely get it. I just want to be friends again.

ALLISON

I don't know if you can do that, Laura.

LAURA

Yes, I can. I promise.

ALLISON

Laura, some things just don't work out. It'll be okay. Please don't call.

Laura starts to cry.

LAURA

Understood. It was nice while it lasted.

ALLISON

Yeah, it was.

LAURA

Goodbye, Allison.

ALLISON

Goodbye, Laura.

They both hang up.

78 INT. LAURA'S HOUSE - DAY

Laura is painting a portrait of Owen and is stoked when she sees the phone ringing.

Intercut with Allison.

SUMMER.

79 INT. MOTEL ROOM - NIGHT

79

Julian enters the motel room and Rooney is waiting for him, looking out the window. She's wearing a small robe that hardly covers her sexy underwear, but the the sad look on her face would take the sexy right out of the room if Julian were to notice it, but he doesn't.

ROONEY

Hi.

JULIAN

Oh my goodness, you look so hot.

He picks her up and throws her on the bed. He starts moving down and kissing her belly, but she stops him and sits up.

JULIAN

What's wrong?

ROONEY

Why haven't you left Allison yet? I mean, you love me, right? You want to be together, right?

JULIAN

Yes, I want to be with you.

ROONEY

You'd choose me?

JULIAN

Yes.

ROONEY

Then why are you still with her? Why are we in a fucking motel room right now?

JULIAN

It's more complicated than that, Rooney. Allison and I are married.

ROONEY

I know. I'm asking when you plan on ending that.

JULIAN

I don't know. (MORE)

JULIAN (CONT'D)

Rooney, I just want to have a nice, romantic evening with you, not deal with this.

ROONEY

Are you just fucking around with me? Are you just saying that you want to be with me so I'll keep fucking you?

JULIAN

No. It's just going to take time.

ROONEY

I'm not going to wait forever. You have to know that.

JULIAN

I know it.

ROONEY

This whole thing is really fucked up. I'm betraying my sister. I'm betraying my sister in a big way and it's hard to live with myself, but I do it because I love you. To me this isn't just about sex, it's about the person I want to spend my life with.

JULIAN

I love you too. And I promise we'll be together. Okay?

ROONEY

Okay.

80 EXT. WHISTLE STOP - NIGHT

80

Owen stumbles out. He pulls out his phone and makes a call.

81 INT. LAURA'S HOUSE - NIGHT

81

Laura lays staring at the ceiling when her phone buzzes.

82 INT. OWEN'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

82

Owen lets Laura in.

LAURA

Hello.

OWEN

How's my favorite night owl?

LAURA

I was sleeping.

OWEN

No, you weren't.

LAURA

I wasn't. Trying to but no dice.

OWEN

All the more reason for a hang.

LAURA

Are you only going to call me drunk in the middle of the night? Is that the extent of this?

OWEN

Of course not. In fact, I already bought a ring.

LAURA

Yeah, right.

OWEN

And I'm not drunk.

LAURA

Is everything that comes out of your mouth a lie?

OWEN

Mostly.

LAURA

You don't ever take anything seriously, do you? That must get to be so annoying.

OWEN

Why are you acting like this? I wanted you to come over so we could have a good time.

LAURA

Acting like what?

OWEN

Like a bitch.

LAURA

Oh, that's real nice.

OWEN

Will you chill out?

LAURA

Don't tell me to chill out.

OWEN

Jesus, you are in a mood tonight.

LAURA

I'm just a little frustrated because I like you, but we never see each other at normal hours, it's solely a booty call.

OWEN

Ha. Booty call.

LAURA

I just feel like I'm being used.

OWEN

Why might that be?

LAURA

You are such a dick.

OWEN

I'm being a dick to you because you're being a dick to me. I wanted to have a good time. You don't have to be here.

LAURA

You're right, I'll be leaving.

She starts out the door.

OWEN

No, don't leave. I know I can be a lot, but I don't want to be alone.

LAURA

Tough shit, Owen.

OWEN

Let's just stop this. Start over. How was your day?

LAURA

Fuck you. You're the biggest asshole and such a baby.

OWEN

I'm not a fucking baby.

83

Owen starts knocking shit over.

LAURA

You're being an absolute baby. You're a shitty person and no one will ever love you.

OWEN

Shut up! Get the fuck out!

LAURA

Way ahead of you. Don't call me ever again, Owen.

She walks out and Owen cries by himself.

83 EXT. MOM AND DAD'S HOUSE - DAY

It's brunch. Allison, Terry, Rooney, Alan and Edith are gathered around the table. They have Mimosas.

ALLISON

Rooney, are you doing okay?

ROONEY

Oh, I'm doing okay.

ALLISON

Do you miss Owen?

ROONEY

No.

TERRY

Owen was not good to you. I'm glad he's gone.

ROONEY

Yeah, me too.

ALLISON

Hey, we went on a bike ride the other day for the first time in ages and Julian said it was on your advice, so thanks for nudging him in the right direction. You know, you should go for a bike ride, dad.

EDITH

Yeah, right.

You've been spending time with Julian?

ROONEY

No, not really.

ALLISON

Terry, we gotta think of someone for Rooney to go out with. I'm sure you can think of someone.

ROONEY

Not interested.

ALLISON

Oh, come on. You need to get over that buffoon.

ROONEY

I am.

ALLISON

You don't seem like it, you're all mopey.

ROONEY

I'm fine.

ALLISON

Terry, you got any ideas?

TERRY

For what?

ALLISON

For someone to take Rooney out? You have to know someone, you're so social.

TERRY

Not off the top of my head, no.

ROONEY

Allison, will you just drop it? I don't want to be set up with anyone. Jesus. Always meddling in other peoples business. I'm sick of it.

ALLISON

I'm just trying to help, you ungrateful asshole.

ROONEY

Yeah, I'm the asshole.

ALLISON

Yeah, you are. You're so...

TERRY

Would you just stop picking on her, Al? That's why she's lashing out. Can't you see she's hurting? Just leave her alone.

ALLISON

Now I'm getting it on both ends?

TERRY

No, you're not. Nobody's attacking you.

ALLISON

Sure feels like it.

EDITH

Would you all please just shut the fuck up? We didn't ask you all here to watch you argue. Jesus, how did we ever live in a house with all three of you.

TERRY

I don't know, Mom, how did you?

EDITH

Burbon.

They laugh. Allison notices that Alan is white in the face.

ALLISON

Oh, no. Dad are you okay?

TERRY

What's going on?

ALAN

I'm fine. Just not feeling so hot.

TERRY

Dad, what's wrong?

ALLISON

Dad, you need to go to the doctor. This happened once already.

TERRY

And you didn't tell me?

ALLISON

He said not too. But two times, you have to go.

EDITH

Should I call an ambulance?

ALAN

No, god damn it. I'm fine. I'll make an appointment with Dr. Jacobs in the morning. I promise.

ROONEY

As long as you promise.

ALAN

I promise. I think I'm going to go lay down though.

TERRY

What the fuck?

84 INT. GOLDEN RYNO ROOM - NIGHT

84

Julian is having a drink by himself. Terry walks in crying.

JULIAN

Hey, what's up? Are you okay?

Terry wipes her tears.

TERRY

Julian. What are you doing here?

JULIAN

Day drinking because I'm sad. I'd guess you're about to do the same.

TERRY

Yeah.

JULIAN

Thought so. I'll get you a drink.

Julian waves down the bartender. Terry sits down.

TERRY

Thanks.

JULIAN

What do you want?

TERRY

Lager.

Bartender gives a thumbs up and goes to get it.

JULIAN

What are you sad about?

TERRY

I think my dad is sick.

JULIAN

Another episode? shit.

TERRY

You knew?

JULIAN

Yeah, it happened a while back and he was forced to tell Allison, but he made us promise we wouldn't tell anyone.

The bartender brings the beer.

TERRY

I see.

JULIAN

You okay?

TERRY

No.

JULIAN

It's scary. I'm sorry. I don't know what you're supposed to say in these situations. I guess you can make him go to the doctor now.

TERRY

I just don't know what to do. I'm not strong like my sisters.

JULIAN

Horse shit. You're just as bit as strong as them. Do you not see it?

TERRY

See what?

JULIAN

That you're the only thing that holds this family together. Those girls would tear each other apart if it wasn't for you.

She looks at him longingly, but covers it up with a giggle.

That's probably true.

JULIAN

I know it's true. You're the strong one. You're Wonder Woman.

TERRY

What are you, Owen?

JULIAN

Don't bring him up, I had almost forgotten about him.

TERRY

I'm Wonder Woman.

JULIAN

Sure are. I'm not making it up. When was the last time you heard the phifer sloppy?

TERRY

What's making you sad?

JULIAN

What do you mean?

TERRY

Why are you day drinking?

JULIAN

Oh. It's not worth talking about.

TERRY

If it's on your mind it's worth talking about.

JULIAN

It's embarrassing. Let's skip it.

TERRY

No, no, no. You're not allowed to do that. I want to hear what's on your mind. I'm here for you. Plus it'll get my dad off of my mind.

JULIAN

Can you keep a secret?

TERRY

Look who you're talking to.

JULIAN

This is a big one.

I'm ready.

JULIAN

This is some life altering if anyone finds out kind of shit.

TERRY

Fort Knox. Just tell me.

JULIAN

I've been seeing Rooney.

Her face drops, but again reacts fast to cover it.

TERRY

I knew it!!

JULIAN

How? We've been so careful.

TERRY

I could smell it. I knew something had to have happened for her to finally break up with Owen. Looks like that something was you.

JULIAN

You're a regular gumshoe.

TERRY

So what's the problem?

JULIAN

Wait? You're not not super pissed?

TERRY

Please, I've been dealing with their love triangles since long before you were around.

JULIAN

But, I'm married to Allison.

TERRY

Yeah, yeah, big whoop. What's got you all mopey?

JULIAN

The tremendous guilt. Of course for Allison, but also Rooney. Rooney wants to be together. She wants me to leave Allison.

Fucking home wrecker.

JULIAN

I can't do that to Allison. I don't want to do that to Allison.

TERRY

Then you should break things off with Rooney.

JULIAN

I know I should, but I can't bring myself to do it. I do want Rooney. I just don't want to uproot my whole life to do it.

TERRY

There's a cliche for that. Something about cake.

JULIAN

I'm such an asshole. I won't leave my wife, but I can't imagine anyone else being with Rooney. It makes me furious. I couldn't handle it when Owen was around.

TERRY

You're pissing all over her.

JULIAN

I don't know what to do.

TERRY

You do, you just don't want to do it. There's a clear right move here.

JULIAN

I know.

TERRY

Man up.

JULIAN

They've really had love triangles before?

TERRY

Oh my god, like you wouldn't believe.

Allison's car pulls into the driveway. She gets out, walks to the door and hesitantly knocks. Laura answers, very surprised.

LAURA

What are you doing here?

ALLISON

I should have called. I'm sorry.

LAURA

No, no, It's a pleasant surprise. I Just had put out of my head that such a surprise was coming.

ALLISON

I missed you, wanted to see you.

LAURA

You want to take a walk?

ALLISON

That sounds nice.

LAURA

Okay.

ALLISON

Okay.

They start to walk.

ALLISON

So, how've you been?

LAURA

If I'm being honest, I've been pretty sad lately. I've spent entirely too much time in bed and at the same time somehow not getting enough sleep.

ALLISON

Sorry for the way things happened.

LAURA

Look, I'm sorry I went a little crazy there for a minute. It was a moment of weakness.

ALLISON

It's okay. I overreacted. it's
just...

(MORE)

ALLISON (CONT'D)

I told you to wait for me to call you.

LAURA

I was just worried that you'd never do that.

ALLISON

But I told you I would.

LAURA

Well, my anxiety over this whole thing wouldn't let me see it that way. I thought you were gone for good. Made me freak out and then actually push you away.

ALLISON

It's been hard for me too. I think about it a lot and I cry. I think about you all the time and I cry. I've fought the urge to call you so many times. You've been occupying a lot of real estate in my head. I didn't want that. I didn't mean for it to mean anything.

LAURA

But it did.

ALLISON

Maybe. But there's nothing we can do about it.

LAURA

Yes, there is.

ALLISON

No, there's not.

LAURA

Why not?

ALLISON

Because I've got a lot to lose. I'm happily married and I want to be with my husband. That's what I want, you just complicated that.

LAURA

How?

ALLISON

don't make it a whole thing. It doesn't have to be.

LAURA

I'm not trying to make it a thing, but it was, and now it can't not be. I've never felt anything like the way I felt when you looked at me at first, then you looked at me with such disgust at the end. It was devastating.

ALLISON

I was disappointed in myself. It wasn't about you. I suddenly realized what an utter betrayal it was to Julian once you wanted thing to get more serious. It wasn't supposed to mean anything, but I think of you all the time. Even when I'm with him. Mostly when I'm with him. I guess I developed feelings that I shouldn't have, but I'm telling you right now, I'm going to squash them down and pulverize them into nothing.

LAURA

So what now then?

ALLISON

Nothing.

LAURA

Until you get lonely again and show up on my doorstep.

ALLISON

I'm not going to do that again.

LAURA

You say that now.

ALLISON

I say that forever.

LAURA

Forever?

ALLISON

You're so pathetic with this puppy love thing.

LAURA

Why did you come here then?

ALLISON

I honestly don't know. I guess I thought we could be friends.

LAURA

Well, then let's be friends.

ALLISON

Do you think you can handle that?

LAURA

It's better than you not being in my life at all.

ALLISON

I don't know if I can trust you the same way again.

LAURA

Why not?

ALLISON

I don't know. It seems tainted now. do you even really want to still be friends?

LAURA

Of course, why would I not?

ALLISON

I don't know. Self respect. Seems like you've lost some.

LAURA

Have you lost respect for me?

ALLISON

Yeah, a lot.

LAURA

Why?

ALLISON

Because it happened, because of the way you reacted, because I just called you pathetic and you didn't defend yourself.

LAURA

Things got weird with me and you just disappeared.
(MORE)

LAURA (CONT'D)

I've felt completely abandoned by you, I didn't think I'd ever see you again, I was devastated by it, but you just show up and you don't think it's going stir up some shit?

ALLISON

I knew it wouldn't be easy. I came anyway.

LAURA

How noble of you.

ALLISON

Oh, fuck you. You don't get to be mean to me. This was all your fault.

LAURA

Are you not going to take even the smallest bit of responsibility?

ALLISON

For my part of it, but my side of the street is clean. I came here as an olive branch.

LAURA

Your side of the street is so fucking far away from clean....
Fuck this. I can't do it anymore.

Laura goes towards the house.

ALLISON

Where are you going? We're not done here.

LAURA

I am.

ALLISON

So that's it, you're just going to leave it like this?

LAURA

Yep.

Allison starts crying and walks towards her car, gets in and drives away. Laura watches Allison drive away.

86

FALL.

Rooney stands reading in the aisle. MORRIS, a handsome reader, passes by her, but sees what she's reading and turns back.

MORRIS

Hello.

ROONEY

Hi.

MORRIS

Sorry to bug you, but I couldn't help notice you reading Solomon Petra.

ROONEY

Isn't he sooo good?

MORRIS

Absolutely. Very good, but very obscure. I was surprised to see someone reading it, so I had to say something.

ROONEY

Oh yeah? Thanks for doing it. Nice to meet a fellow fan. Rooney.

She holds out her hand. He shakes it.

MORRIS

Morris.

ROONEY

Pleasure to meet you, Morris.

MORRIS

Have you read his others?

ROONEY

I've read "Blood Claws", but not, "Birds in the Window".

MORRIS

Oh, you have to, it's so good. His use of imagery in the denouement is just wonderful.

(MORE)

MORRIS (CONT'D)

Without giving anything away he's really good with setting up things perfectly that you never realize are coming back. You really have to read it.

ROONEY

I will, I will. Right after this one. You've talked me into it. You're a little salesman.

MORRIS

Rad. Well, have a nice day.

ROONEY

You too.

He walks away. Rooney watches him.

ROONEY

Hey, Morris.

MORRIS

Yeah?

ROONEY

Have you had lunch yet?

87 EXT. BLIND LADY - DAY

Morris and Rooney are having lunch.

ROONEY

Have you seen "Sushi Toy"?

MORRIS

Yeah, it actually is one of my favorites of the genre, being that it was based on an Italian gaillo film. Are you familiar?

ROONEY

Yes, I really love "Orange Twins".

MORRIS

A great one.

ROONEY

Hey, Morris, you don't read comic books do you?

MORRIS

Not since I was 12. Why?

87

Alan throws a ball for Boomer. Terry sits next to him.

ALAN

Damn, that little fucker is fast.

TERRY

Dad, that really scared me the other day.

ALAN

You've got nothing to worry about.

TERRY

I'm worried about you. What would I do without you?

ALAN

Look, nothings going to happen to me, but if it did, you'd be fine. You more than your sisters.

TERRY

What do you mean?

ALAN

You've got your head on your shoulders in just the right way. In a way your sisters don't. I'm very, very proud of you, Ter.

TERRY

There's nothing to be proud of, I haven't accomplished anything.

ALAN

Says you. In my eyes you've accomplished a whole hell of a lot. I am so thoroughly proud of the woman you've become.

TERRY

Thanks, Pop. That means a lot.

ALAN

Can you keep a secret?

TERRY

You know I can.

ALAN

You're my favorite.

Whatever.

ALAN

It's true. I'm not kidding around. Don't tell your sisters.

89 EXT. BALBOA PARK - DAY

89

Morris and Rooney sit outside the museums.

MORRIS

One brother. We're pretty close. Although we have completely different lives. He's a fire fighter, loves football, just a totally different world, but we get along. You?

ROONEY

Two sisters. Both crazy. I'm the sane one if you can believe it.

MORRIS

I don't believe that for a second.

ROONEY

It's true, it's true.

106 EXT. STELLA JEAN ICE CREAM - DAY

106

Rooney and Morris walk out with cones.

MORRIS

Mom and Dad still together?

ROONEY

They're still together, but there was a rough patch. I was 13. They got divorced. A lot of trauma came from that period for me. I was kinda neglected. My mom was drinking a lot and my dad couldn't hack it. Allison, my older sister was the closest thing to a parent through that period, but she was basically the same age as me.

MORRIS

Wow, that's heavy.

ROONEY

It caused a lot of shit and fucked us all up, but we never talk about it, at least not in a real way. None of them ever want to.

MORRIS

You can talk to me. I'm a good listener.

ROONEY

Thank you, you really are.

MORRIS

But they're together now?

ROONEY

Yeah, but they never remarried. We joke that they're boyfriend and girlfriend.

MORRIS

So they talk about it a little.

ROONEY

Yeah, that and my dad complaining about divorce lawyers is about the extent of it. "They'll try to take every god damn thing, I was prepared to give her half".

MORRIS

Well, at least you can joke about your childhood trauma.

ROONEY

I mean, it's not like they were terrible parents. Now they're pretty wonderful. They like to get the family together at any opportunity. Gatherings and such. There was a lot of music growing up. They keep that up.

MORRIS

Oh, yeah? You play?

ROONEY

Yeah. I play piano and I sing.

MORRIS

I'd love to hear it sometime.

ROONEY

Sometime. Maybe. Probably not.

MORRIS

Don't be shy about it.

107 EXT. KOOK BENCH - DAY

107

Rooney and Morris watch the sunset overlooking the beach.

108 INT. MORRIS' CAR - DAY

108

Rooney and Morris laugh and make eyes as the drive trough.

90 EXT. PARK BLVD. - NIGHT

90

Rooney and Morris walk together. They're both smiling. Morris takes her hand. Rooney interlocks their fingers.

91 EXT. MOVIE THEATER - DAY

91

Rooney and Terry walk away from the concession stand and into the theater. They have popcorn. Terry's smile is big.

ROONEY

Terry, I really like him, he's so incredibly sweet and thoughtful and all the things that I would have never dreamed when I was with Owen, but, I don't know, I feel like I'm betraying Julian.

TERRY

That's stupid.

ROONEY

I know, it's ridiculous, but it's hard to get over it. I cared a lot about Julian. I think we both know it's better if we're not together, but we haven't talked about it.

TERRY

You probably should.

ROONEY

I know. We haven't talked much though. I guess I've kinda been avoiding it.

You don't owe him anything, but you probably both should get some closure on the situation.

ROONEY

But I can't help but hold onto the idea that he's going to leave Allison. I mean, he told me he loves me and wants to be with me.

TERRY

Roon, that's not going to happen.

ROONEY

But he hasn't said those words.

TERRY

He has to me.

ROONEY

Really?

TERRY

When he told me about the whole thing he said he couldn't bring himself to leave her.

ROONEY

Fuck.

TERRY

But you don't want that anyway. You don't want to ruin your own sisters marriage.

ROONEY

You're right. I don't.

TERRY

And Julian is my bud, but he can be shitty. He does stupid things. this new guy sounds great. Why don't you focus your energy on him?

ROONEY

I know. You're right.

Rooney gets a call and answers it. at the same moment Terry get's a text and checks it.

TERRY

Holy shit!

92	EXT.	HOSPITAL	_	DAY

92

Allison rushes in the main entrance.

93 INT. HOSPITAL WAITING ROOM - DAY

93

Allison sits with Edith and Terry.

EDITH

I don't know. he was complaining about his arm. He was completely white. Then he was on the ground and I called 911. He asked me to say a little prayer for him. He's not religious. Oh my god.

ALLISON

It's going to be okay, Mom.

Rooney is standing in the doorway alone. Julian approaches.

JULIAN

You've been distant. What's up?

ROONEY

Are you crazy? Not here. Not now. Are you fucking serious?

94 EXT. HOSPITAL - DAY

94

Rooney and Julian stand in front of the hospital.

JULIAN

Well, who is he?

ROONEY

Just someone I met. You don't know him. It doesn't matter anyway.

JULIAN

Why doesn't it matter?

ROONEY

We don't have a future. You're not going to leave Allison. Ever.

JULIAN

And this guy is as good as me?

ROONEY

What kind of question is that?

JULIAN

You're leaving me for this guy, he must be better, right?

ROONEY

Julian, I'm not leaving you, we're not together.

JULIAN

Are you in love with him?

ROONEY

I don't know why this is relevant. You're clearly still in love with my sister.

JULIAN

Answer the question.

ROONEY

Yes, Julian. Alright. Head over heels. I can't wait to have his babies.

JULIAN

Don't be an asshole.

ROONEY

You're the asshole.

JULIAN

Oh, Rooney. I can't bare to think about another man being with you.

He touches her face, she pulls away.

ROONEY

Tough shit, Julian. I'm done waiting. It's over. Doneski.

She walks away. Julian squats down and rubs his face.

95 INT. HOSPITAL WAITING ROOM - DAY

95

Allison looks out the window and sees Rooney and Julian.

96 INT. HOSPITAL WAITING ROOM - DAY

96

Edith is crying and flailing and Allison, Rooney, Terry and Julian are trying to calm her down. This is in slow motion.

97 EXT. 28TH AND REDWOOD - DAY

97

A funeral procession drives through and intersection. The last car with flags passes.

98 INT. TOWN CAR - DAY

98

The second car of the procession. Julian drives, Edith shotgun, and the sisters in the back seat. Everyone is very sad.

99 EXT. CEMETERY - DAY

99

Everyone is in black and sad. Millie, Abe and their kids are there. Millie's bandmates, Laura, Maisy and Marco are too. Morris is with Rooney. And a bunch of other family members.

Terry puts the the last dirt on the coffin. She stays there for a while. Edith comes and puts her hand on Terry's shoulder.

EDITH

Let's go.

TERRY

I want to stay for a minute.

Edith walks away. Terry sits by herself, bawling.

100 EXT. CEMETERY PARKING - DAY

100

Allison puts Edith in the back seat of a car and it drive away. When she turns around Laura is there.

ALLISON

Hi.

LAURA

Hi.

ALLISON

Thanks for coming.

LAURA

I'm so sorry, Allison.

They hug. Laura waves and gets in her car. Everyone is leaving.

101 EXT. CEMETERY - DAY

101

Terry and Allison are walking.

ALLISON

Rooney seems pretty serious about this new guy. To bring him to our father's fucking funeral.

TERRY

Don't be mean. He's being supportive. He can't help it that he's the new boyfriend.

ALLISON

Why are you always defending everyone? It's fucking annoying. Why can't you ever be on my side?

TERRY

I'm always on your side. I know you're hurting, but I am too, we all are. Be careful before you say something really hurtful.

ALLISON

I'm sorry. You're right. I'm just really sad about Dad. And I'm irritated because it looks like Rooney and Julian are running around together. I've suspected it for a while, but it's getting worse. Like it's right in front of my nose now. The day Dad died they went off by themselves at the hospital. and look, they're together now.

In the distance Julian is running up to Rooney.

ALLISON

I don't know. Am I crazy? I may be making all of this up in my head.

Terry's face drops. She struggles for a moment finding what she's supposed to say.

TERRY

You're not crazy, but there's nothing going on. You're overthinking.

ALLISON

You know something.

TERRY

What?

102

ALLISON

Terry, you're a bad liar, now what do you know?

TERRY

Is this really something you want to get into right now? It's not the best time.

ALLISON

No, now is the perfect time.

102 EXT. CEMETERY OTHER SIDE - DAY

Julian catches up to Rooney, who is walking.

JULIAN

Getting pretty serious if you're going to invite that asshole to your father's funeral. What a lovely date.

ROONEY

Fuck off, Julian. Leave me alone.

JULIAN

I'm sorry, it's just that this guy's a clown. I think you should ditch him.

ROONEY

What do you know about it?

JULIAN

I know that I'm in love with you.

ROONEY

Missed the fuck out of that train.

JULIAN

Just give me another chance. I'll leave her this time.

ROONEY

Julian, you're pathetic.

JULIAN

Why are you being so mean?

ROONEY

Do you really have to ask that?

JULIAN

Yes, I do.

Morris walks up.

MORRIS

Is everything okay over here?

ROONEY

Yeah, everything is fine, Sweetie.

JULIAN

Sweetie?! What the fuck is that?

ROONEY

Shut up, Julian.

MORRIS

You got a problem, buddy?

JULIAN

Not that's any of your business, asshole.

MORRIS

Don't be disrespectful, look at where we are.

JULIAN

Don't condescend me, you piece of shit. I'd love an excuse to rip your fucking throat out.

ROONEY

Julian, What the fuck? You can't say shit like that? Chill the fuck out!

MORRIS

It's okay, babe. I know how to handle guys like this.

JULIAN

Don't call her babe.

MORRIS

What?

Allison walks up. Terry behind.

ALLISON

Are you two fucking each other?

JULIAN

Who?

MORRIS

yes.

ALLISON

You and Rooney.

JULIAN

What? No.

ALLISON

Don't lie to me, Terry already told me.

TERRY

No I didn't.

ALLISON

She did with her face.

JULIAN

What are you talking about?

ALLISON

Have you been sleeping with Rooney?

JULIAN

Of course not.

ALLISON

Is that why you two have been all chummy? Is that why you ran off the day Dad died?

JULIAN

No.

ALLISON

Tell the truth, I can handle it.

JULIAN

Allison, Rooney is your sister, I wouldn't...

ROONEY

We have been. It's over now, It's over now, Morris. But we were together. For nearly a year.

ALLISON

A year?

JULIAN

Allison, I want to be with you. I don't...

ALLISON

Shut up. I can't believe you could do this to me. After all that shit about "No more extra marital relations" Well, sex with my sister definitely qualifies as extra fucking martial relations.

ROONEY

Al...

ALLISON

And I can't even look at you. I'm just disappointed in both of you.

TERRY

Oh, come on, Allison.

ALLISON

And you, you knew the whole damn time.

TERRY

Yeah, I did know, because for some reason that's beyond me, everyone tells me everything, so I knew, just like I know about you and Laura.

JULIAN

Laura?!

ALLISON

Oh, shit.

TERRY

You're talking down to them when you're guilty of the same god damn shit.

JULIAN

You promised that that was a one time thing.

TERRY

But, Julian, you've been cheating on her with Rooney. You're all acting like babies. And this is not the time time act like babies. I mean, Jesus, he's been in the ground for like 15 minutes and you've all already moved on to your own shit.

(MORE)

TERRY (CONT'D)

He was dying in front of us, there were signs and we all ignored it because everyone was consumed with their own bullshit. We didn't spend the last few months we could have with Dad because everyone was fucking everyone. So selfish. So 90210. He'd be so disappointed. He was disappointed. He was just too sweet to show it. I'm ashamed. All of you should be ashamed. This is all so ugly and toxic. Can we just be done with it and mourn our fucking Dad?

Terry walks away. Morris puts his arm around Rooney and they walk away. Allison and Julian are left standing there.

JULIAN

I'm sorry.

ALLISON

I'm sorry too, but I don't want to be with you.

JULIAN

Yeah, I don't want to be with you either. I want to want to, I just don't anymore.

ALLISON

This is all so sad. My life is falling apart and I don't have my Dad to pick me up...

She starts to cry.

ALLISON

To pick me up like he always has.

Julian grabs Allison by the arm.

JULIAN

I'm sorry for your loss, Allison.

He walks away. Allison is left standing there. She walks off into the sunset in slow motion.

THE END. ROLL CREDITS.

EXT. NOW OR NEVER COMICS - DAY 103

A disheveled Owen comes out of the comic books store. A disheveled Julian is walking down the street. They see each other and walk up, nose to nose and just look at each other for a moment. They both attack and roll around on the ground.

104 INT. GOLDEN RYNO ROOM - DAY

104

Owen and Julian have bloodied up and bruised faces. They sit next to each other drinking beers, not speaking.
